2007 Syrah de Favel - Syrah de Favel is produced by Jean-Francois Favel in the southern French region of Costieres de Nimes. The area is considered part of the Rhone Valley and was once the delta for the Rhone River. The 2007 vintage was outstanding in this part of France. The terroir from these vineyards is very similar to those of Chateauneuf-du-Papes, with very shallow soil and plenty of large rocks throughout the terrain that make the vines work extra hard for nutrients and naturally promotes lower yields. Elegant black fruits, notes of smoke, spice and grilled meats contribute to this wine's complexity. A great house red to enjoy not only during the holidays, but year round. **\$11.99**

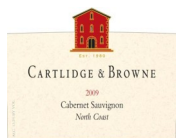

2010 Marco Porello Roero Arneis Camestri - If we could only use one word to describe this Arneis it would have to be "gorgeous". Noted as being one of the oldest white varietals in the region, Arneis originated and is still primarily grown in the hills of Roero in Italy's northern appellation of Piedmont. Located just north of Alba, this estate grown wine comes from well drained, eastern positioned, meticulously maintained sandy sloped vineyards. Marco Porello puts forth a lovely fresh apple, pear and floral scent. The soft fruit flavors combine a persistent rich quality edge that is framed in a fine acidic structure that is followed with a long citrusy and spiced finish. Treat your guests this holiday season by serving this delicious white along with warm or cold hors d'oeuvres, as they might just thank you for offering a great alternative from the usual Pinot Grigio. **\$15.99**

2009 Cartlidge & Brown Cabernet Sauvignon North Coast - Produced from grapes sourced primarily out of vineyards in Sonoma's Knights Valley and western portions of Napa Valley, Cartlidge & Brown Cabernet Sauvignon exhibits an affordable, straightforward and friendly style. The wine shows vibrant fresh berry, cedar and mocha aromas that leads you into its smooth medium-bodied texture filled with layered flavors of black cherry and cassis fruits accented with bright mid-palate acidity. Its alluring subtle notes of vanilla, licorice and warm silky tannins are followed with an elegant and youthful finish. This subtle well balanced red saw 10 months of ageing in a combination of French and American oak for added complexity. Pair this with roasted pork, beef and game bird. **\$12.99**

2009 Bodega Tukma Malbec Reserva - The consumer's relentless appetite for Argentinean Malbec continues to reach amazing new heights every year. Malbec's deep and copiously rich style positioned at reasonable prices is the key to what makes this red wine category so attractive. Tukma Reserva is one of our newest additions to our vast selection from this South American wine region. This limited production bottling comes from the Tolombon Valley, which is just outside Cafayate in the country's northern most viticultural region of Salta. At roughly 5,200 feet above sea level, the vineyard experiences extreme temperature fluctuations, sometimes as much as 50 degrees from day to night, that promotes rich grape concentration with thick skins and well developed tannins. This deep red starts off with aromas of ripe plum, a hint of pepper and new oak. The full-bodied structure envelops a mix of dense black fruits balanced with subtle earthy mineral and spices. Tukma Reserva's distinct qualities culminate with long, sweet and smooth oaky tannins. Enjoy over the next 3-5 years along with a range of roasted meats and aged cheese. **\$12.99**

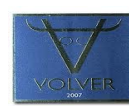

SIX SUMPTUOUS REDS for \$99.00



2006 Serradenari Barolo DOCG - This recently discovered producer from the northern Italian wine region of Piemonte came to the Connecticut market with a surge of excitement. Serradenari is one of the region's smaller producers, yet delivers large in quality. This Barolo played right into the hands of our unwavering quest of seeking out the best quality driven wines available. In fact, this fine selection from Italy was one of our best more recent finds. This limited production Nebbiolo based red unveils full aromas of smoky black cherry accented with tar and earthiness. It has all the classic expression by possessing a variety of big, rich and succulent black fruit flavors, combined with an expansive oak structure, fresh roasted coffee, vanilla, black licorice and firm tannins. Drink now or hold for the next 7-10 years. \$24.99

2008 Encierra Vineyard Reserve - When small production wines like this comes along with such expressive qualities and structure, it is often a reminder as to why Chile has earned its spot as one of the world's viticultural super powers. Adriana Cerda and Maria Ignacia Eyzaguirre are two gifted Chilean winemakers that have joined together in the making of this magnificent full-bodied blend. The wine is composed from their estate's prime vineyard plantings of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Carmenere, Syrah, Merlot and Petit Verdot, situated in the Perallilo portion of the Colchagua Valley. Having such a selection of concentrated grapes has provided the best results for producing this deeply structured blend by revealing a ripe core of blackcurrant and bramble fruits. The wine's bold texture is balanced with numerous layers of spice, a dusty earth quality with mature tannins. The wine completed its development with 12 months of ageing in both French and American oak. With the benefit of some aeration, this wonderful and complex red can be enjoyed now and over the next 5-7 years. \$19.99

2009 Chateau Guillou Montagne Saint Emilion - This classic structured Saint Emilion unleashes many of the fine qualities that one has come to expect from the widely touted 2009 Bordeaux vintage. From their four hectare vineyard estate that sits atop the western Montagne, St Emilion hillside, Chateau Guillou is produced from high quality vines averaging 55 years old. This superbly well made Bordeaux rouge is a blend of 75% Merlot and 25% Cabernet Franc. The wine exhibits a dusty earth scent with dark berries and subtle oak. It has an expansive mix of dark fruit and ripe plum flavors followed by sweet oaky tannins, balanced with vivid layers of spice and mineral, along with a full rich finish. Though Chateau Guillou still shows to be quite young, a short period of aerating is recommended to give the wine its appropriate time to open up and display its true essence. Enjoy over the next 5-7 years. \$19.99

2008 Clos de los Siete - This Argentine bottling was produced by *Michel Rolland*, one of the most famous winemaking consultants in the world. The vineyards lie in altitudes of 3,000 feet or higher with high density plantings and tiny yields at under two tons per acre. It has very favorable growing conditions, including excellent sun exposure, low annual rainfall and a cooler climate from its close proximity to the Andes Mountains. Clos de los Siete shows tremendous concentration of smoky black fruits, mineral notes, a seamless texture, followed by a lasting complex finish. This wine packs as much flavor and character as any \$30+ wine in the market. Enjoy this blend of Malbec, Merlot, Cabernet and Syrah now and over the next five years. \$17.99

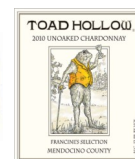
2009 Volver Tempranillo - Volver hails from La Mancha, the largest D.O. in Spain. The area is relatively flat and one of the largest winemaking regions in the world. Surrounded by mountain ranges on each side, temperatures range from single digits in the winter to over 100 degrees in the summer. This release comes from a 72 acre vineyard planted over 40 years ago. The Tempranillo from this single vineyard is very low yielding, resulting in a concentrated and powerful wine. This wine is bottled and released after seeing 14 months in new French oak. It is black in color, bursting with licorice, vanilla and loads of black fruit on the palate. This fleshy, yet oppulent wine is quite staggering considering its attractive price tag. Rated 90 by Robert Parker, drink now to 2015. \$14.99

2003 Grangehurst Cabernet/Merlot - Grangehurst is a traditional, low tech producer that uses minimal intervention in the natural process of vinification to express the wine's true characteristics and the terroir of origin. Grangehurst utilizes old world methods, such as the usage of open fermentation tanks and old fashioned wooden basket presses. The entire grape selections are handpicked from four prime vineyard sources throughout Stellenbosch. Owner/winemaker Jeremy Walker of Grangehurst Winery believes in maturing his wines before release to help give the final product optimal time to soften and develop more complex flavors, with use of French and American oak barrels playing an essential role in the ageing process. Aged in barrel for twenty nine months, this opaque blend offers complex Bordeaux-like aromas by showing dusty earth, mineral, good oak integration, dark chocolate, along with spice and plenty of black fruits. On the palate it has an enormous rich concentration of blackberry, cassis and plum flavors, balanced with shades of mocha and vanilla, blanketed in a firm tannin structure. \$19.99



SIX PREMIUM CHARDONNAYS

Chardonnay is arguably the noblest and most celebrated white wine in the world. With a vast range of styles, results vary mainly dependent on the particular region's terroir expression and method of winemaking. Chardonnay's history dates back over numerous centuries. The most noted place of origin comes from the esteemed French Burgundy wine region. Producers throughout the world have historically referenced and aspired to emulate these quality driven wines nearest in style to those produced from this acclaimed region. Key components that are instrumental in providing the most favorable growing conditions are sun, soil and a long cool climate.

Chardonnay aged in oak barrel, when done properly, can play an important role in the outcome of the final product. When it comes to the use of oak a winemaker has three critical decisions to make: whether to select French, American, Hungarian or other types of oak; whether to use barrels that are new, seasoned, or a combination; and if new, whether to request a light, medium or heavy toast to the inside of the barrel. Regardless of the style or type of barrel used, one of the best examples comes from the French A.O.C. of Cote de Beaune where most employ oak in moderation.

There are many other crucial decisions besides the usage of oak a winemaker makes each vintage. For example, the concept of fermenting and ageing in stainless steel tanks is another way of producing wonderfully complex Chardonnay. This puts more emphasis on preserving a fuller expression of a wine's cleaner fresh flavors and bright acidity, along with other structured nuances that reveal the natural qualities of the region. Another important event that affects the wine's outcome is the selection of ideal grapes. Malolactic fermentation, which is done by converting lactic acid into malic acid, and "sur lie" ageing are two more winemaking choices that are considered for added complexity and correct balance.

Exploring this fantastic group of American and French Chardonnays may allow you a better understanding of this fascinating grape varietal's unique and broad styles. In varying degrees, they present a rich, ripe and full-bodied structure that are held together with great acidity, balanced with freshly concentrated flavors of citrus, pear, apple, peach and mixed tropical fruits, followed with regional authenticity. Some of these Chardonnays will offer additional primary and secondary characteristics including subtle notes of smoky toasted bread, vanilla, nuts and almond, butterscotch, honey, spice and minerality.

2008 Olivier Leflaive Bourgogne Les Setilles – This Bourgogne Blanc is in a classic style made entirely of declassified Chardonnay from younger, low lying eastern vineyards from the prestigious Meursault and Puligny Montrachet A.O.C.s. This wine shares some of the best qualities of these appellations, and at roughly two thirds less in price. Once blended after being vinified and aged separately in French oak and stainless steel tanks, the wine offers layers of ripe apple and citrus flavors, balanced with a nice mineral edge on the mid palate. Noticeably similar to a well made Pouilly Fuisse, Les Setilles puts forth a full-bodied richness, underlined with a compelling acidic structure that carries through onto the persistent finish.

2010 Domaine Alain Pautre Petit Chablis - The Petit Chablis sub-region is situated just outside the main Chablis A.O.C., which is part of the larger Burgundy appellation. Alain Pautre is considered an exceptional winemaker that many feel can rival the top producers of Premier Cru Chablis. This superb Petit Chablis, made entirely of Chardonnay, was fermented and aged exclusively in stainless steel tank. As mentioned in the top of the article, this process allows the wine to put forth a pure terroir expression of the region by revealing all of the classic characteristics of French Chablis with its distinct citrus aroma and flinty notes. The wine possesses full structured fruit flavors of lemon, peach, apple and tropical notes, along with wet stony mineral, balanced acidity and a long ripe finish.

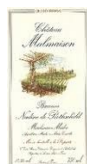

Cameron Hughes Los Carneros Lot #222 Chardonnay - This impressionable white represents a compilation of meticulously selected grapes. Sourced from the cool wine growing region of Los Carneros, which is situated in the southern portions of Napa and Sonoma Valleys, this rich, ripe and full-bodied white gives exceptional balance and complexity that is somewhat reminiscent to that of a French Meursault, yet is classic Californian in style. It starts with a hint of toasty fruits, the flavors then move into rich apple, citrus and tropical fruits that balance with subtle oak and a terrific acidic structure. Compares well to Chardonnays double in price. \$15.99

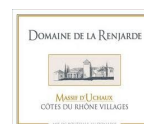
2009 MacRostie Sonoma Coast Chardonnay—Steve MacRostie founded this Sonoma winery in 1987. His style has always been of balance and moderation. Some of the fruit comes from his own Wildcat Mountain Vineyards, while the rest are from select growers in the Sonoma Coast region. The wine is aged on the lees for six months in a combination of French and American oak, which only 20% is new. This 2009 shows pear and green apple fruit, good crisp structure and a long persistent finish. \$21.99

2010 Toad Hollow Mendocino Chardonnay - This very well received Toad Hollow is a wonderful “un-oaked” Chardonnay that was held for nine months in stainless steel tanks. Stylistically, the wine is reminiscent of French white Cote de Beaune. The wine went through 100% malolactic fermentation and the fruit was left on its lees (natural deposits) for an eight month ageing period. This process ensures good acidity and natural expression of the fruit. The fresh pear, apple, citrus and tropical fruit flavors provide further complexity, with a crisp mid-palate and a layer of cream on the long rich finish. \$13.99

2009 Ken Wright Cellars Chardonnay - Produced from one of Oregon’s top winemakers, Ken Wright has done a spectacular job by capturing the essence of two unique vineyard sites, the Celilo Vineyard from White Salmon, Washington and the Del Rio Vineyard from Golden Hill, Oregon. These vineyard sites experience a long cool growing period which give the grapes extended hang time on the vine coupled with fine sun exposure for proper grape sugar and acid balance. This delicious wine serves up vividly fresh spices along with lovely apple aroma, which lead you into a clean, crisp and acidic style offering complex flavors with ripe, rich, full-bodied creamy fruit structure of citrus, pear, apple and tropical hints that carry through onto the alluring finish. \$25.99

2008 Chateau Rocher Figeac - Situated on the right bank of Bordeaux, in the Merlot dominant A.O.C. region of Saint Emilion, Rocher Figeac unveils a wonderful wild berry and oaky scent. On the palate, the wine shows youth and concentration, yet possesses some age worthy character with its smooth tannin structure and subtle spices, followed with an opulent core of mixed berries and ripe plum flavors that showcases the true essence of Saint Emilion. Enjoy this classic styled right bank rouge over the next 4-6 years. \$19.99

2009 Domaine Chofflet Valdenaire Givry - The Givry A.O.C. is located within Burgundy’s Cote Chalonnaise, which is just south of the Cote de Beaune. Chofflet is a well-structured Pinot Noir that offers full terroir qualities and a stylishly youthful expression of the great 2009 vintage. The wine serves up a wonderfully spice texture with mixed fruit flavors layered in blackberry and cherry, balanced with acidity, subtle forest floor and smooth tannins. Enjoy this 90 point rated red Burgundy over the next 4-6 years. \$21.99

2007 Domaine de la Voute de Crozes - Produced from the artful hands of Nichole Chanrion, this Cru Beaujolais of the Cotes de Brouilly is as beautifully well-made Gamay as you will find from this region. Voute de Crozes is a small four hectare site where the yields are kept low to maintain the highest quality. The Cotes de Brouilly region is known for producing ripe concentrated reds that are expressive and distinctively terroir driven. The lovely floral aroma leads into well-balanced flavors of wild cherry, red raspberry and ripe strawberry. The tannin sensation gives a silky textured expression, while the acidic structure lends itself to the supple spices. Enjoy this 90 point rated Cru Beaujolais over the next 2-3 years. \$19.99

2009 Domaine de la Renjarde Cotes du Rhone Villages - The Domaine’s property is comprised of vines averaging more than 40 years old that yield grapes of remarkable quality. This family operation is also tied into the renowned Chateau La Nerthe, which is one of the top properties in the Chateauneuf-du-Pape A.O.C. It is of no surprise that this Cotes du Rhone Villages exhibits such endowed quality. Renjarde is a traditional blend of southern Rhone grape varieties consisting of Grenache, Syrah, Cinsault, Mourvedre and Carignan. The wine shows incredible youth and structure with its inviting sweet spice, dark fruits and smoked meat aroma. The robust and rich flavors give way to the ripe layers of red and black cherry, balanced with shades of earthy spice, roasted coffee and cocoa, gripped with fine young tannins. Enjoy this magnificently well-made 89 point Rhone over the next 5-7 years. \$17.99

2006 Chateau Malmaison - Over to the left bank of Bordeaux, in the Moulis-Haut Medoc A.O.C., this mature styled offering is both Merlot and Cabernet based. The wine is lavishly structured with deep concentrated dark berry flavors, accented with earthy spice tones, dusty tannins followed by a long, rich, sweet oaked finish. Enjoy this Wine Spectator Top 100 Bordeaux rouge over the next 3-5 years. \$19.99

2008 Blason d' Ausseries - This full-bodied Languedoc rouge, located in the Corbieres A.O.C., comes under the direction of the vast wine firm Domaines Barons de Rothschild Lafite. Blason d'Ausseries is an outstanding quality red that truly represents the old world country style of the Languedoc. It is blended with the near identical grape selection as the previous wine in Domaine Renjarde, though it is quite different in its flavor profile. This wine is round, ripe and supple, having a copiously dark, rich blackberry and raspberry concentration, combined with a nice integration of spices and rusticity. Enjoy over the next 3-5 years. \$17.99

2009 Allegrini Palazzo Della Torre - Allegrini is one of the top estates in the Veneto for Valpolicella and Amarone. Palazzo Della Torre is a single vineyard bottling that breaks from the traditional rules by substituting Sangiovese and Syrah for the required Molinara variety to finish off the blend with Corvina and Rondinella. As a result, the wine cannot be called Valpolicella. Allegrini feels the D.O.C. rules do not allow for the highest possible quality of wine, much like the first wineries to make Super-Tuscans. Palazzo is full-bodied with layered flavors mixed with rich, ripe black cherry and currants, along with notes of licorice and vanilla. Enjoy this consistently rated 90 point Veneto red over the next 5 plus years. \$19.99

2008 Aia Vecchia Lagone - This Tuscan I.G.T. blend has had quite a following since we first featured it over a decade ago. Coming from two vineyard sources on the Tuscan coast, Lagone is a blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Sangiovese. Tibor Gal, former winemaker for Super-Tuscan great Ornellaia, was brought in to consult with this project. The wine possesses Bordeaux-like complexity with Italian terrior richness by showcasing an abundance of black fruits tied into earthy mineral tones, cassis and a solid structure on the finish. Enjoy this 90+ point Tuscan red over the next 3-5 years. \$15.99

2009 Cantina Colosi Nero D'Avola - Colosi exhibits a rich, yet more elegant style of Sicily's native Nero D'Avola grape variety. This I.G.T. starts out with a lovely floral and spiced berry scent that is a result of being vinified and aged entirely in steel tank. The wine shows a more assertive and acid structure that is enveloped in a rich flavor concentration of wild cherry, plum and bramble fruits, backed with a velvety texture, layered in young tannins. Enjoy this Sicilian favorite over the next 3-5 years. \$15.99

2007 Viticcio Chianti Classico Riserva - This is an important winery to watch for years to come. The Landini family has some of the finest vineyard holdings in the famed Greve district of the Chianti Classico D.O.C.G.. This is a classic Chianti Classico Riserva that stands out with tremendous balance and structure. It has a terrific aroma of sweet dark cherry and cedar highlights. On the palate, you will find some rustic earthiness, a full-bodied core of mixed fruits, marked with licorice and tobacco, along with soft tannins that adjoins the long fruity finish. Enjoy this Wine Spectator Top 100 Chianti Classico over the next 5-7 years. \$24.99

2007 Vietti Nebbiolo Perbacco - This Piedmont red is a very unique wine in how it is made. Of all Vietti's holdings in various Crus, they bottle four single vineyard Barolos on their own. The Nebbiolo from all the other Crus is harvested, fermented and blended together. After a period of ageing, the entire lot is tasted and separated into two parts. The first part that is bottled without further ageing goes into Nebbiolo Perbacco, while the second part undergoes additional time in barrel and is bottled as Barolo Castiglione. If aged a bit longer this wine would have been entitled to the Barolo designation. Instead it sells for half the price of many Barolos and represents a tremendous bargain. Enjoy this 92 plus declassified Barolo over the next 5-7 years. \$24.99
